3.a. Approval of Minutes

3. SGT Business

No review of minutes from previous meeting.

3.b. Suggested Guidelines for Adoption of New CC Classes.

- 1. Suggested guidelines for adoption of new Community College classes presented by Jennifer Huszar with Handout. (Informational)
 - Jennifer H went through the handout points 1-7 and explained what each of them meant.
 - Jennifer H was looking for feedback on the guidelines.
 - Suggestions were that classes that are offered should augment and not duplicate classes that are already offered at UCHS and that would augment existing curriculums.
 - · Survey students to find out what classes would be preferred.
- 2. UCHS student addressed the SSGT requesting the ethnic studies be an option for students and expand History to include other ethnicities. (Informational)

3.c. Healthy Start Campus Plan.

Update on Healthy Start Time for next year. 90% of UCHS teaches polled wantee a 6 period day versus 4X4 Block Schedule- we should hear the exact time late in January.

3.d. Implementation of the BOE Graduation Requirement for the Class of 2024.

- 1. Mr. Olivero Provided two handouts, "For Class of 2024 and Beyond" and SDUSD Ethnic Studies Compliant Courses and explained that the District was including Ethnic Studies as a graduation requirement starting in 2024.
- 2. The SSGT discussion resulted in a proposal to change all 9th grade English classes to the Bullets of Truth English curriculum for next year.
 - 3. The District will be providing training this spring to help support teachers in this transition.

SSGT proposed to offer two options in 2020-2021 Proposal by Mr. Olivero with Second by Kelsi Bradshaw. (Voting: 7 – Yes, 1- Abstain)

- 1. Keep cluster and seminar sections, but the overall curriculum will be the Bullets of Truth for all 9th graders instead of English 1 and 2. This shift will make sure all 9th graders take care of their required Ethnic Studies class their 9th grade year (meeting 2024 requirements).
 - The SSGT members thought this was a better option than having advanced students wait until they are juniors and seniors years to fulfill their required Ethnic Studies requirement.
 - \cdot It was acknowledged by Mr. Olivero that there will be some work to do in helping teachers implement this new curriculum.
- 2. Allow next year's juniors and seniors the option of taking a two-semester community college class on History of Black Perspectives and Introduction to Chicano Studies.

- Juniors and Seniors will be able to take this sequence as one of their elective options for next year. UCHS teachers could possibly instruct these courses but they must have a master's degree in history.
- Jennifer H. asked if UCHS teachers can put together an ethnic studies class that will meet the requirements. Mr. Olivero answered yes, but they would need to get approval from the District and College Board.
