UCHS ELAC would like to offer the following advice to SSC for the 2016-2017 school year Title I Budget;

1. It would be beneficial to the Spanish Speaker students at UCHS to offer Spanish for Spanish Speakers Course. This would enable Spanish speakers to improve their writing and reading skills to prepare them for honors and/or AP Spanish.
2. It would be beneficial to Long term English Learners at UC to offer Academic Language Development ALD course next year. : ALD is a course designed to build academic language, critical thinking, and critical writing skills for Long Term English Learners (LTEL). Students in grades 6-12, who have been enrolled in our system for six or more years, perform at the Below Basic or Basic level on the CST, and who have a CELDT level of Early Intermediate or higher may be enrolled in the course. This course is considered a high level language development course for LTELs. As such, it will serve as an elective in the students' schedules and be taken concurrently with a grade level English course.
3. It would be beneficial to students who are having difficulty in course classes to offer Saturday Tutoring in Science, Social Studies, Math and English as part of the Saturday Success school program.
